Increased Web visibility for your collections

OCLC has partnered with leading search engines (Google, Yahoo!, Bing) and popular social networking and bookseller sites to increase library visibility online. When users link from these sites to WorldCat.org™, they can easily connect directly to your locally branded WorldCat Local site.

Users have direct access to electronic resources from search results when you load your data into the WorldCat knowledge base. A 'View Now' link on brief records connects users directly to available electronic articles and open-access content. A-Z lists, inbound and outbound linking to full text is also supported by the knowledge base.

And with browser-based, mobile-optimized views, WorldCat Local keeps your collection mobile-ready no matter what tablet or mobile device your users have. No app download required.
