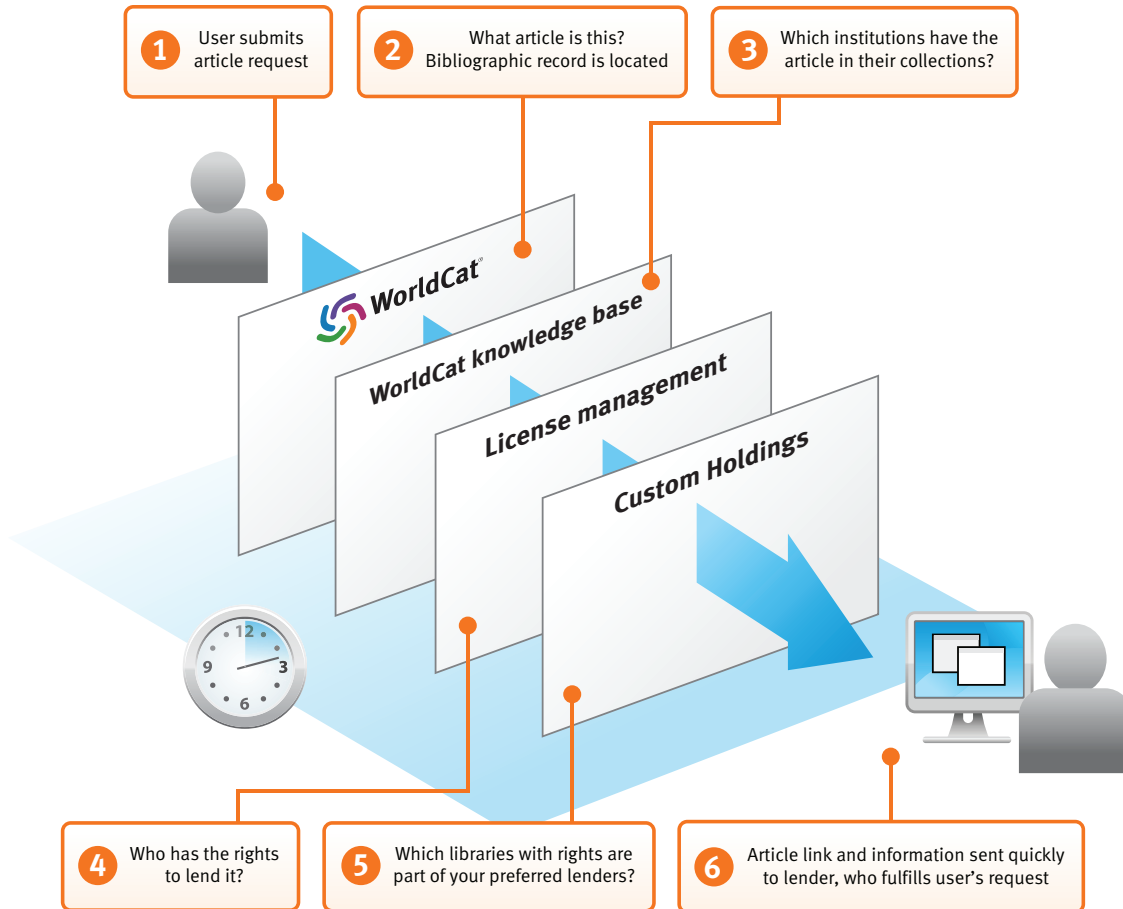


Cut your interlibrary loan turnaround from days to hours



Save time and increase user satisfaction with a new article-sharing feature in WorldCat Resource Sharing and ILLiad.

By adding your local data to the WorldCat knowledge base and adding license management information to OCLC Service Configuration:

- ILL requests link directly to requested electronic articles when your library owns the content and can lend it based on your license rights
- Lending staff link directly to the requested article—no more searching multiple content locations.

When both borrowing and lending libraries using Direct Request have added local data to the WorldCat knowledge base:

- Lending libraries are identified more accurately
- The requested item's URL appears in the ILL request, which saves staff time spent on requests for items the library already owns.

Get started now:

1. Complete a WorldCat knowledge base initiation request: <https://www3.oclc.org/app/worldcat/wckb/>
2. Use instructions at www.oclc.org/us/en/support/documentation/resourcesharing/ersa/ to load local data to the WorldCat knowledge base
3. Enter license data into OCLC Service Configuration: www.worldcat.org/config
4. Turn on access to the WorldCat knowledge base in the WorldCat Services administrative module

For maximum benefits: Set up the Direct Request feature

Using data in the WorldCat knowledge base, WorldCat Resource Sharing and OCLC ILLiad can now streamline access to your library's e-books and the open-access content represented in the knowledge base. Now, the services alert ILL staff to requests for this content and link them to it. Best of all—it's all included in your WorldCat Resource Sharing and ILLiad subscription at no additional charge.

To start saving time for ILL staff and users now:

1. Turn on access to the WorldCat knowledge base in the WorldCat Services administrative module
2. Create a profile for "etext" in the WorldCat Services administration module using these instructions: www.oclc.org/us/en/support/documentation/firstsearch/managing/directill/directill.pdf
