
VIAF: The Virtual International Authority File

Sweden Ends Negotiations with OCLC

The following guest post is by Maria Kadesjö who works at the <u>Libris-department at the National</u> <u>Library of Sweden</u>.

The national library of Sweden has <u>ended negotiations with OCLC</u> on participation in WorldCat, as the parties could not come to an agreement. The negotiations go back to 2006 and the key obstacle for the national library has been the record use policy. Some time into the negotiations OCLC presented certain conditions for how records taken from WorldCat for cataloguing were to be used in Libris.
