I think there is a mechanism/program in place especially for small publishers of non-English materials to place their materials in WC.org-just like B& T is doing. Given that this mechanism exists or can be created, can OCLC take the next step and provide (either directly or thorough a partner) access to EDI capabilities so that those small publishers can provide streamlined e-procurement channels similar to what we enjoy with Ingram, B&T and others?- M.
