- **OLIB 8**
 - Beta testing now
 - Formal release 4th January 2010
- **Service Packs**
 - More information to follow
- **Lancaster Release**
 - 12 months

- RSS feeds
- Link checker
- Vista compatible
- Z39.50 record import for cataloguing
- Multiple keyword indexes
- Fines & other charges
- Circulation messages
- In-transit processing

- Look and feel
- Single sign on / authentication
- Shopping basket
- Account details
- Location profile

- Aim for production release in 12 months
- IMS items
 - Bug fixes
 - Enhancement suggestions
- Reporting, Circulation, Existing functions....
- TouchPoint
- Oracle upgrade

- Easy to use and requires minimal or no training.
- Ideally has a “dashboard-style” configuration tool
- Able to deliver reports in the following formats:
 - Simple table display
 - Charts
 - Data exportable to MS packages
 - Reports must be printable and emailable
- It must be possible to ship pre-configured reports with OLIB

- It must be possible for customers to create their own reports
- If a third party tool is to be used it must either be free, or extremely cheap!
- It must be a widely recognised reporting tool
- Must be possible to use with OLIB WorldView or OLIB Web

Reporting....where are we?



- Had workshop
- Looked at Crystal reports
 - Too expensive
 - No good for hosted solution
- Looking at Jasper
 - Open source
 - Web-based
- OLIB Lancaster release....

OLIB RELEASE STRATEGY

- RSD
 - Rapid deployment of bug fixes.
 - Managed via hotlist
- New software versions
 - 12 - 18 - 24 months
- Requirement from users to fix more bugs

New Release Strategy



- RSDs
 - No change
- Service Packs
 - 6 month intervals
 - First one June 2010 (ish)
- New Software versions
 - No change

- Bug fixes
 - Only items with the stats of “bug” on IMS
- User installable
 - IT installable!
- No training
 - Comprehensive notes
- No charge!
 - Not mandatory

- No charge for software
- Charge to install
 - Unless you take it with an upgrade
- Small increase to annual support
- Can use both client interface
- Options for hosted solution

- OLIB 8
- OLIB Web

- **Currently WebView**
 - Needs additional functionality
 - Web 2.0
- **OCLC to settle on two EUE**
 - End User Environment (Interface)
 - Next generation OPAC
- **Deployable / WorldCat**
 - TouchPoint
 - WorldCat Local

- Use Solr Lucene as search index & engine
- Bib records “pushed” to index
- Holdings accessed in real time using NCIP
- Option to use Fast as search engine
 - Cost implication
 - Not priority for OLIB

- On target to “launch” with OLIB Lancaster
 - Likely to pilot during middle 2010
- Upgrade to replace WebView
 - “basic” implementation
 - Includes facets, Z39.50, spell check
- “Premium” - offers meta search
 - Addition cost
 - No date
