

## National Palace Museum Online Database

Now available from NetLibrary, the National Palace Museum (NPM) Online database by Airiti, Inc. represents the world's most complete and feature-rich eContent offering for ancient Chinese art treasures. A valuable resource for libraries, art schools, museums and other cultural institutions, NPM Online contains 12,000 images and related description articles of the art pieces in the collections of the National Palace Museum in Taiwan.



### Chinese art and antiquities

The NPM Online collection, authorized by the National Palace Museum in Taiwan, is a valuable resource for exploring photo images and artifact descriptions from one of the world's premier cultural institutions.

Created primarily for educational and academic research purposes, NPM Online was awarded the Best Subsidized Digital Publication by News Bureau of the Executive Yuan of Taiwan in 2005.

### Built by professionals for optimal views

A professional consulting group, comprised of researchers from the National Palace Museum and history professors from the Taipei National University of the Arts, carefully selected images of works that span seven millennia of Chinese history and prehistory.

The high-resolution images have an optimum display size of 1024 x 768 pixels. A zoom-in function provides immediate, clear views of particularly intricate details.

Because of the high-resolution and high-quality of NPM Online's images, users may view the finest details in a piece of art, as if examining the art in person.

The NPM Online database marks the NetLibrary platform's expansion into images, in addition to eBooks, eAudiobooks and eJournals.

### Search features for quick retrieval

NPM Online provides advanced search and browse capabilities that make it easy for users to research and study the databases' entire collection of world-class Chinese cultural treasures.

The advanced search tool enables users to search by category such as calligraphy, ceramics, bronze, Buddhist antiquities, jade, painting and rarities. The sort feature refines search results by dynasty, creator or title. The chronology link enables users to browse the entire database in chronological order. All search features are supported in three languages: Traditional Chinese, Simplified Chinese and English.
