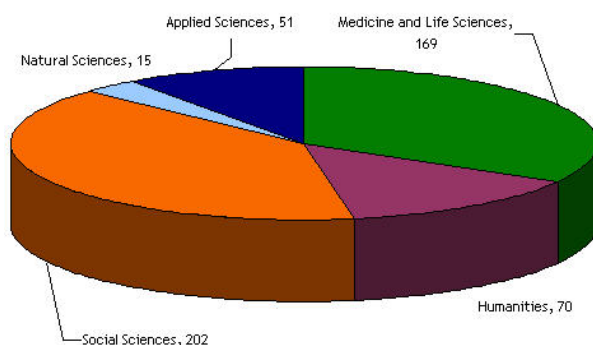
Now available from NetLibrary, the Taiwan Electronic Periodical Services (TEPS) by Airiti, Inc. offers the largest collection of full-text Taiwanese periodicals in the world. Currently TEPS contains 81,000 articles from more than 500 Taiwanese periodicals, and they're all available now through the NetLibrary platform. A valuable resource for students, faculty and researchers in the sciences and humanities, TEPS provides a fast and convenient way to find Taiwanese articles. Please note that while TEPS can be purchased separately, a subscription to TEPS is included as part of Airiti's Chinese Periodical Services (CEPS) subscription, as well.

Academic research periodicals

Updated daily, TEPS provides a comprehensive view of Taiwanese scholarship since 1991. Any scholar or researcher interested in Taiwan, its manufacturing, culture or relationship to China will find hundreds of journals with subjects covering:

- Social sciences
- Medical and life sciences
- Humanities
- Applied sciences
- Natural sciences

The graph below illustrates the relative distribution of main subject area content in TEPS, along with the actual number of periodicals.

As standard collection criteria, Airiti selects journals cited in leading Taiwan and academic indices including:

- Science Citation Index
- Social Sciences Citation Index® (SSCI®)
- Engineering Index
- Taiwan Social Sciences Citation Index

Search, browse and download full text

With both quick and advanced search features, users can conduct full-text searches of the entire database, or browse by subject, publisher or title. Once researchers identify full-text content, they can easily download it as a PDF.

TEPS is one of three Chinese language eContent offerings by Airiti available from NetLibrary. Other databases include the Chinese Electronic Periodical Services (CEPS) and the National Palace Museum (NPM) Online.
