

NetLibrary collection options for your library

NetLibrary offers a number of ways for you to expand, or launch, your eContent collection. Our collection development librarians build unique eBook and eAudiobook collections, including TitleSelect collections, Subjects Sets and—based on your specifications—custom collections to meet the unique needs of your library and users.

TitleSelect collections

TitleSelect collections represent lists of titles on a particular subject area. We tailor the collection subjects to your type of library and choose them specifically because of their timeliness, importance in the market or their ability to promote awareness of the topic. Whenever possible, these lists are frontlist only (2006 - present). New, relevant titles are added weekly and title counts range from 50-400 titles.

Additionally, we do not filter TitleSelect collections for geographic or consortial restrictions, so please remember to confirm title availability before ordering.

Subject Sets

Subject sets contain a fixed number of titles with a fixed price and focus on a particular subject area. They are a great way to get your eContent collection started.

A NetLibrary librarian selects each set to ensure high quality content. Currently there are many options for academic, community colleges, corporate/government and public libraries.

We develop Subject Sets around NetLibrary's highest use subject areas. They include only frontlist titles and do not contain duplication between sets. Finally, they are available for worldwide sale (no territory restricted titles are included), but are not consortia eligible.

Custom collections

We can specifically tailor custom collections to any and all library requirements. Therefore, they may yield more focused collections than either TitleSelect collections or Subject Sets. In other words, our collection development librarians develop a collection based on criteria that you determine.

Custom collection requests are meant to be used only when TitleSelect collections and Subject Sets do not fit your library's needs. The custom collection form is integral to the process of developing your collection, so please take the time with your OCLC representative to provide as much detail as possible.
