1. Ask library staff to help you get to a WorldCat search page.
2. At the Advance Search page, enter the topic or key word you want to research in Search for: field and click **Search**.
3. Search results appear in a numbered list of brief records.
4. Use the **Related Subjects** or **Limit** buttons on the top to expand or fine-tune your search.
