**Circle Theatre**  
Once filled with residences, the southeast quadrant of Monument Circle became known as the Kingdom Midway, the Circle Park Hotel, Wood's Livery, and the Baldwin Piano Company. In 1916 the Circle Theatre was built, and big changes started to occur on the quadrant.

**Events on the Circle**  
In the original plan for Indianapolis, Monument Circle was designed as a park, a place for people to gather. Throughout time, the circle's purpose has changed, but it has always been a place for people to gather.

**Neighborhoods**

**The English Theater**  
For the first half of the twentieth century, the northwest quadrant of Monument Circle was home to the landmark English Hotel and Theater. William H. English, one of Indiana's first and wealthiest businessmen and politicians, built and owned the hotel and theater.

**Explore The Monument**  
The idea for building a monument in Circle Park started as early as 1867, when several local businessmen, Daily Journal suggested a monument to honor the Indiana soldiers who had lost their lives in the Civil War. Today the monument remains one of Indiana's most famous and beloved landmarks.

**The Southeast Quadrant**  
In the early to mid-twentieth century, when Indianapolis residents wanted to catch the latest flick or live act, they headed to the Circle Theatre on Monument Circle. Before the theater was built in 1916, a livery stable held the center spot of the southeast quadrant.

**The Trest Building**  
In 1904 the Trest Building, addition to the "Grand Old Quadrant" at Monument Circle, the Trest Building. The structure was commissioned by the Trest family and




