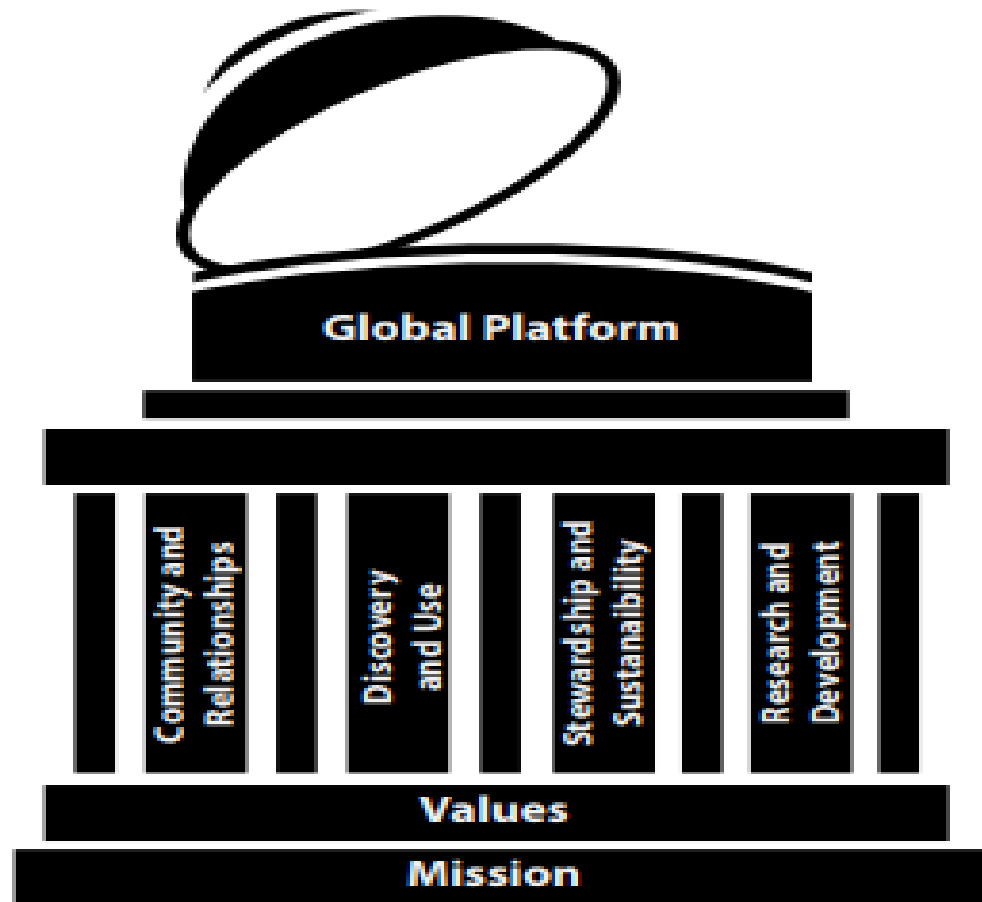

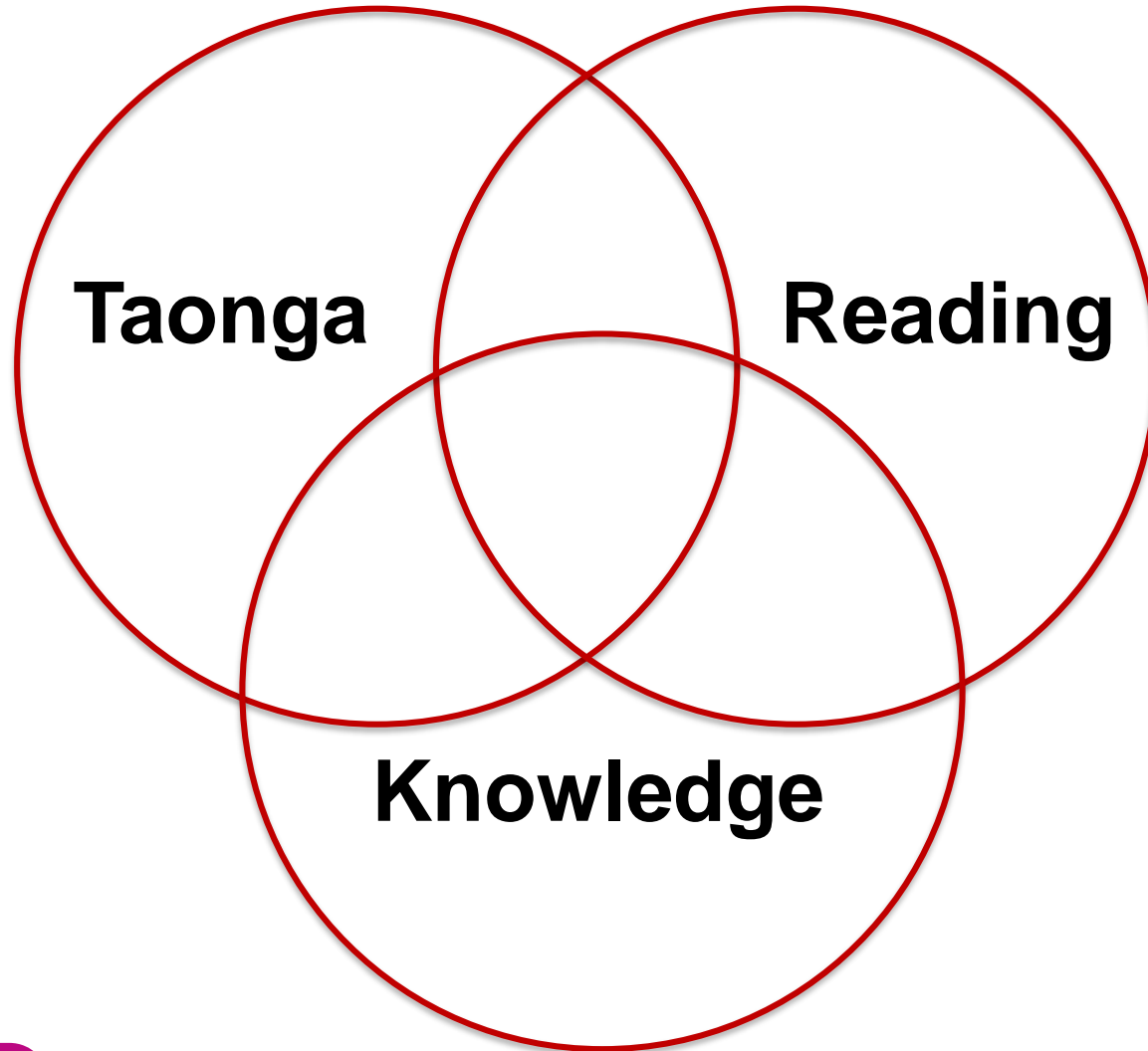

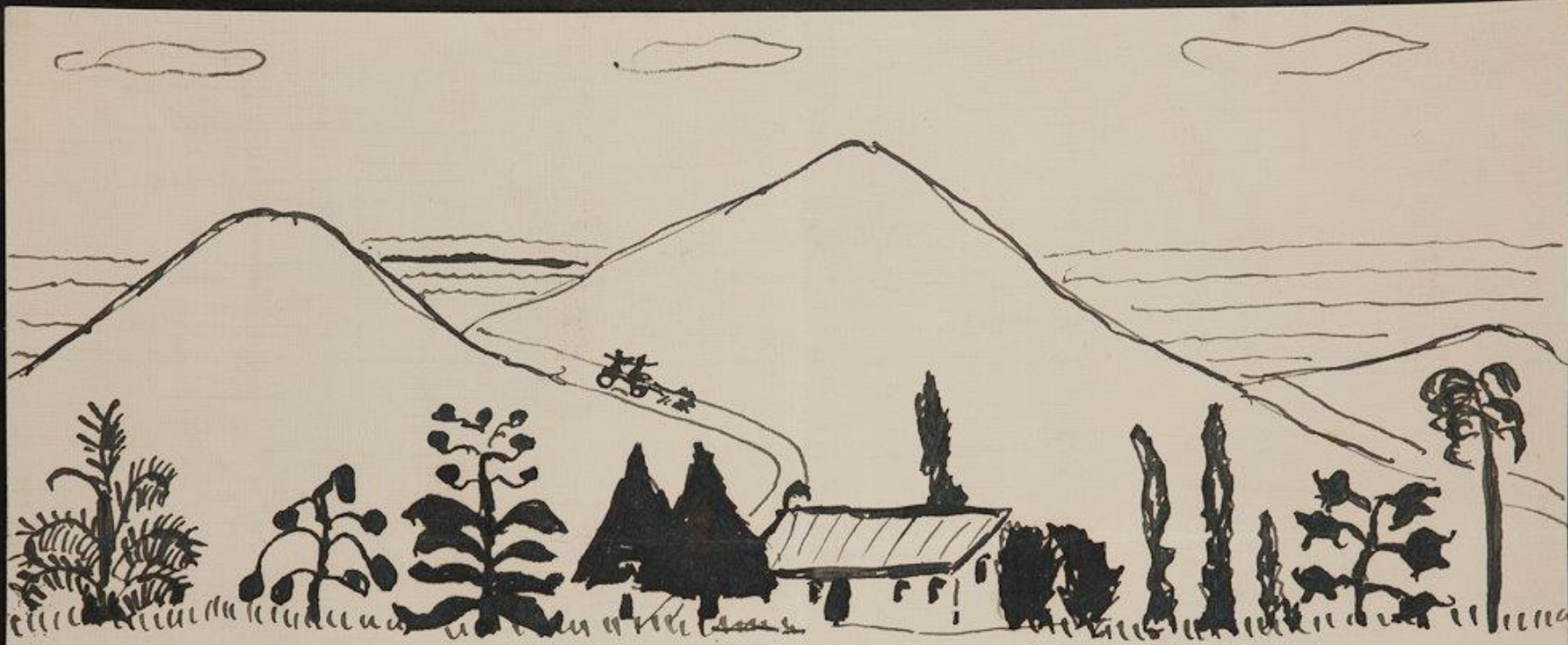
Turning Knowledge into Value

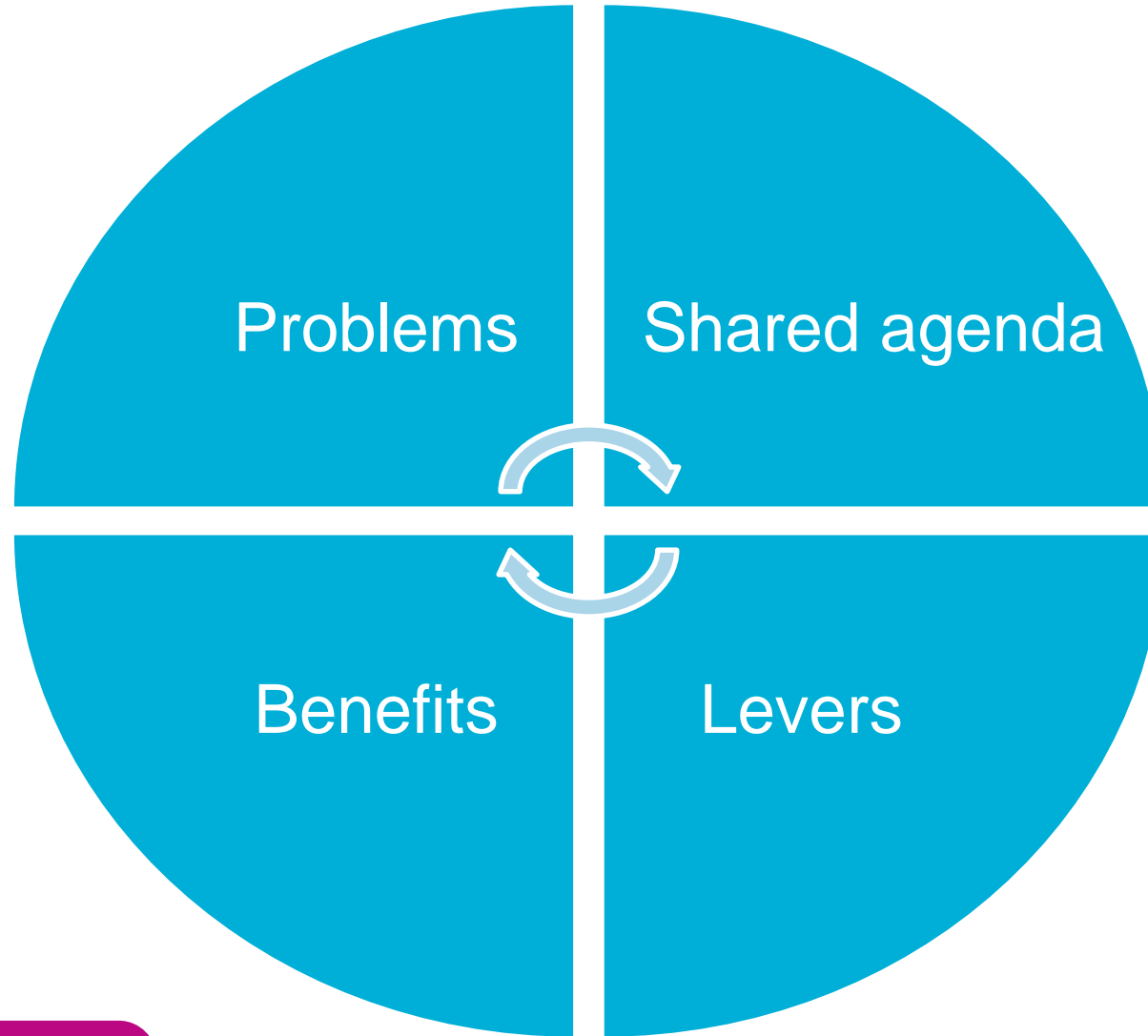
