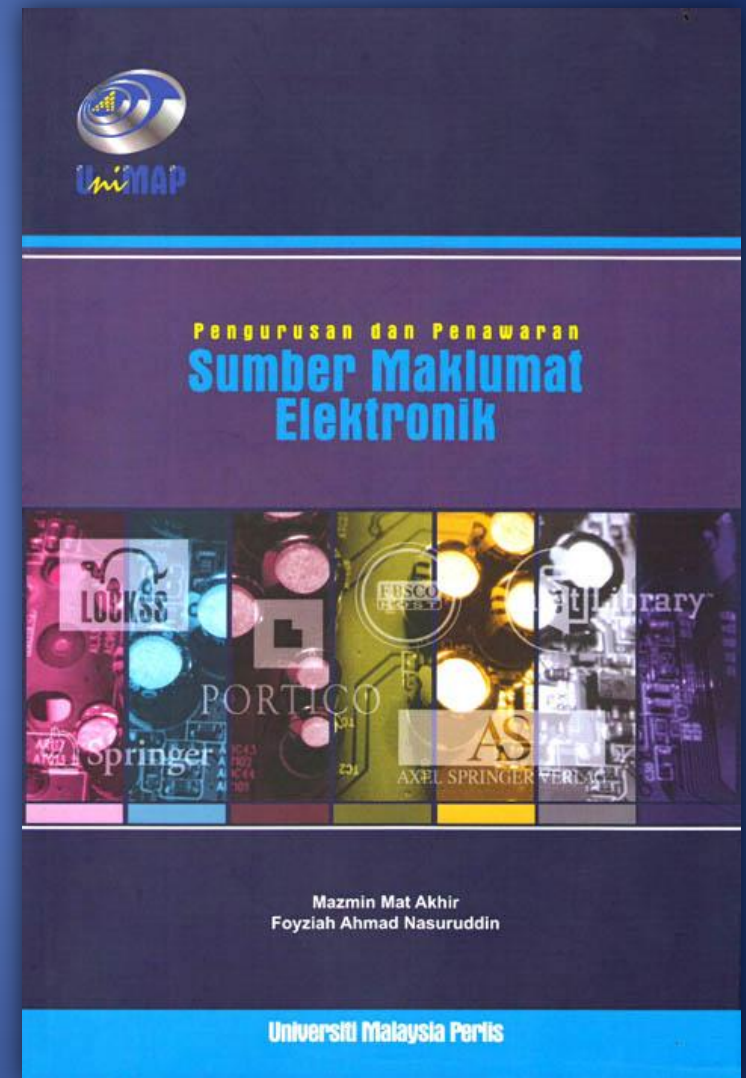

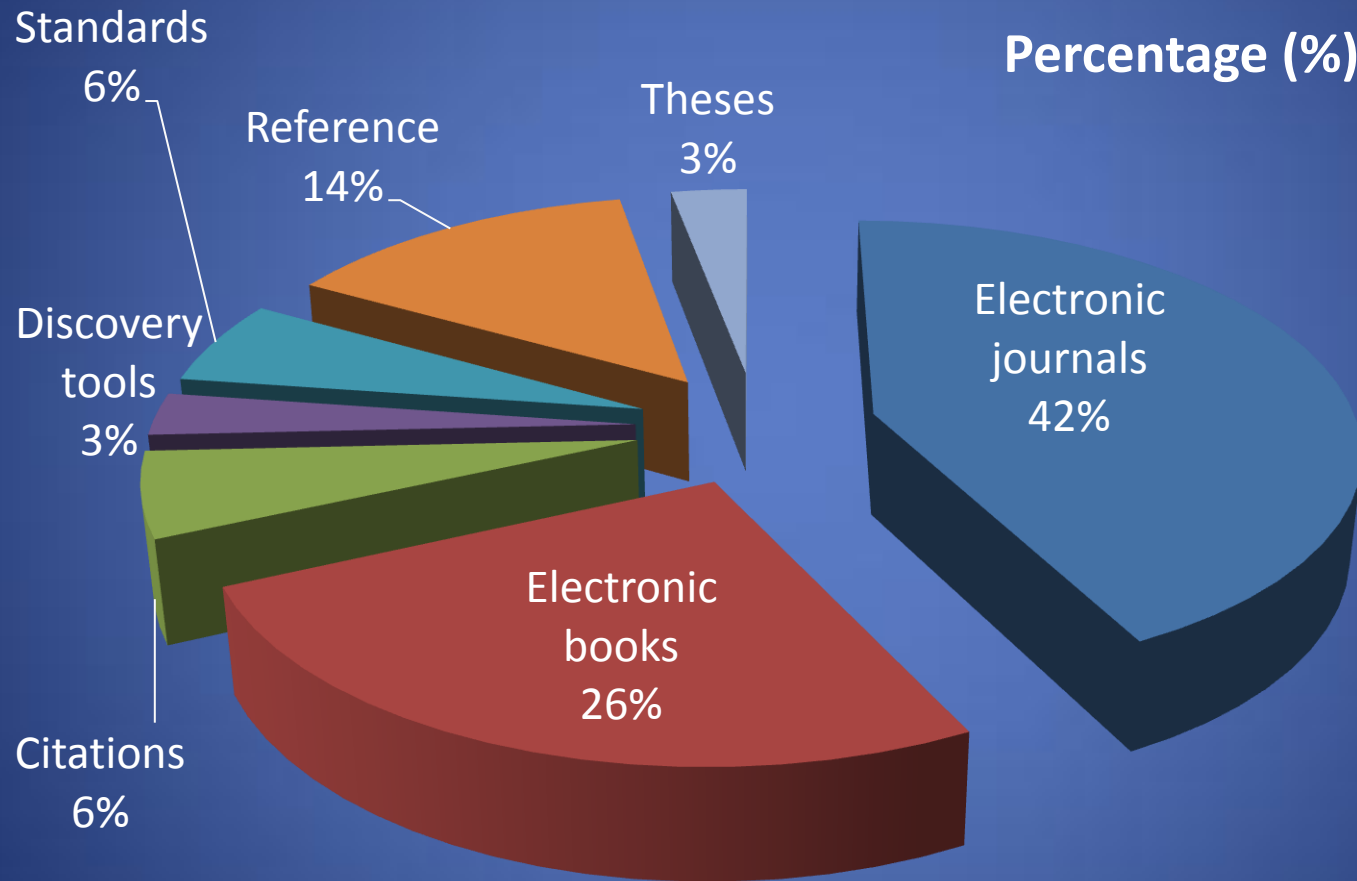


THE IMPORTANCE OF ELECTRONIC RESOURCES IN UNIMAP

- ➡ 80% of our academic staff are below age 35

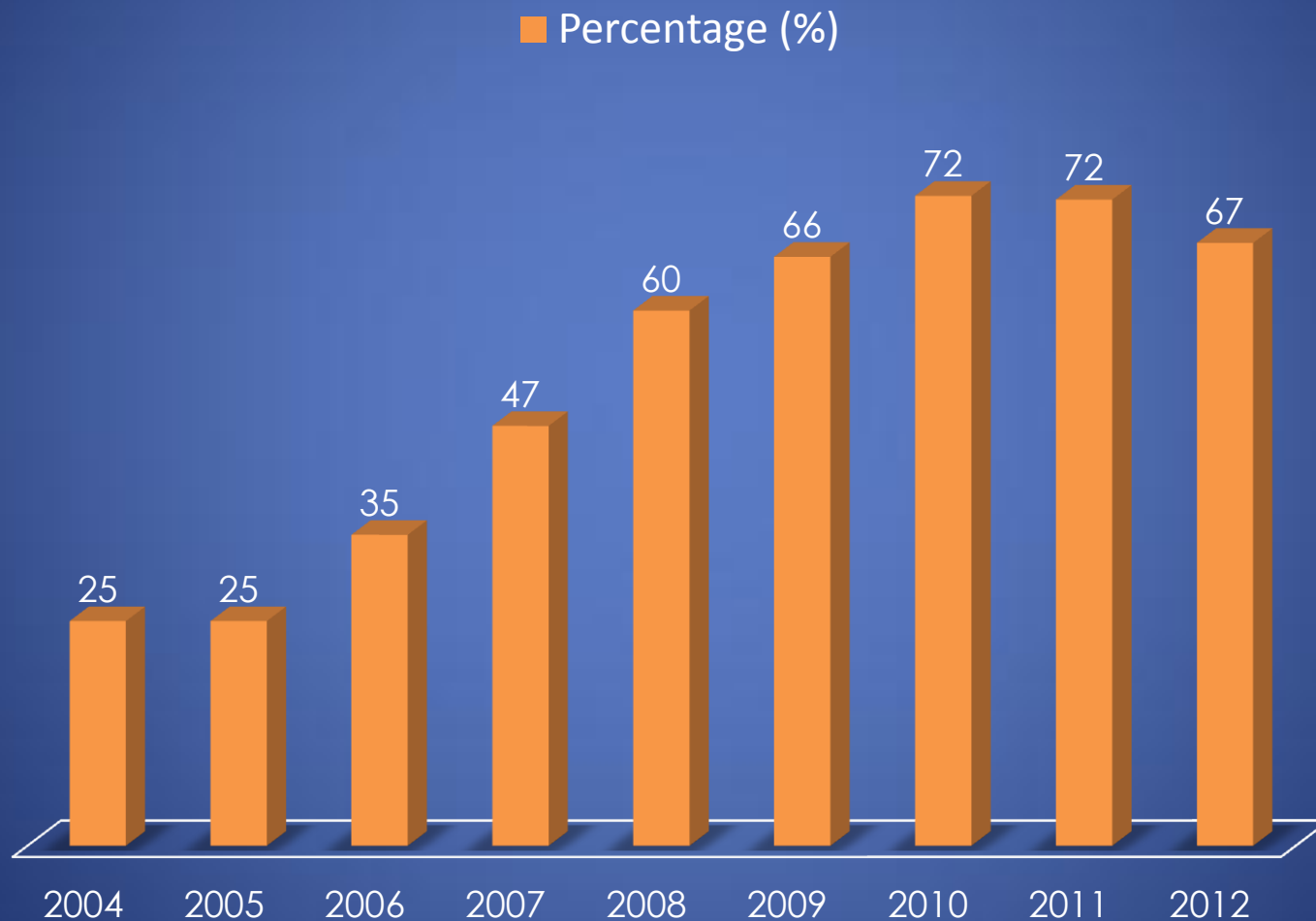


TYPES OF ONLINE DATABASES @ UniMAP LIBRARY



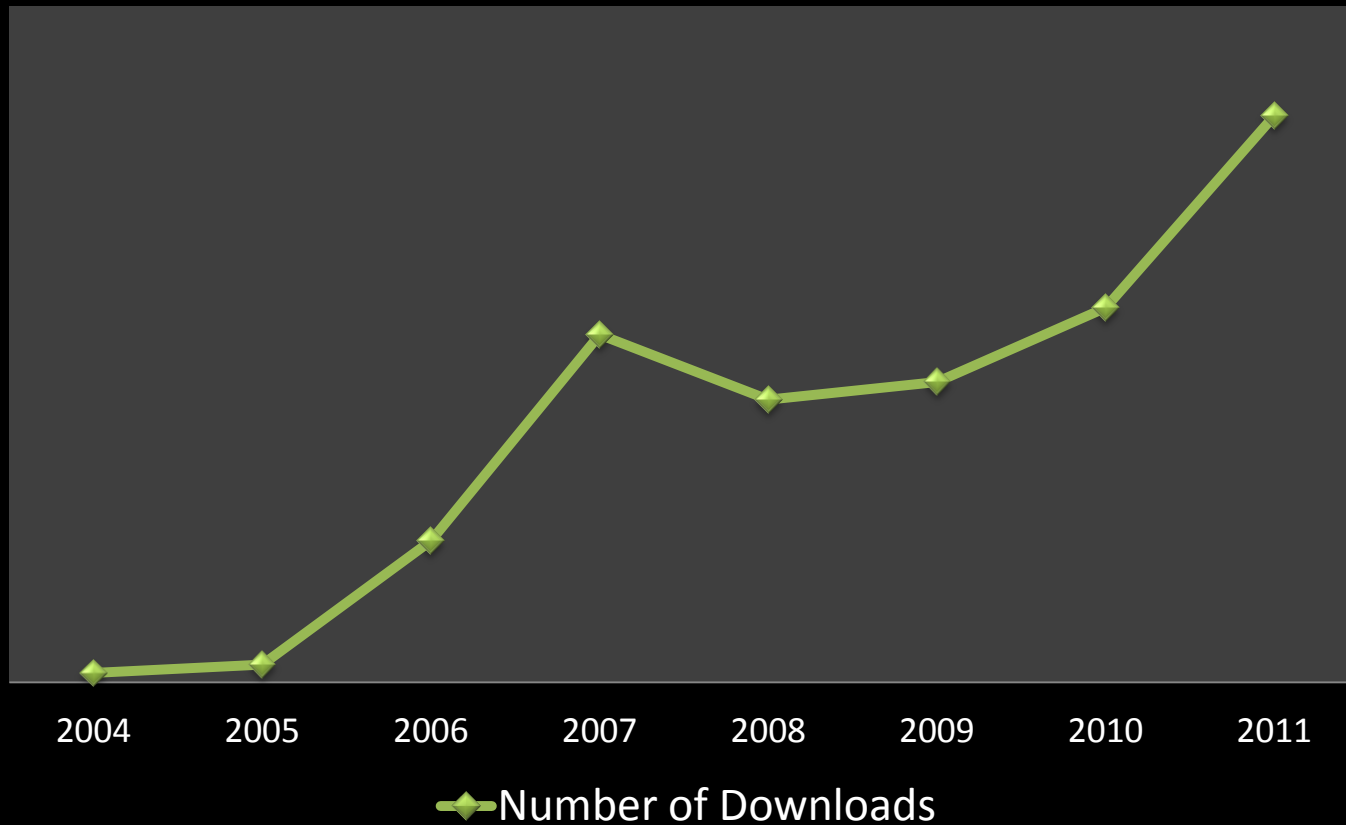

SUBSCRIPTIONS AND ACQUISITIONS OF ELECTRONIC RESOURCES (2004–2012)

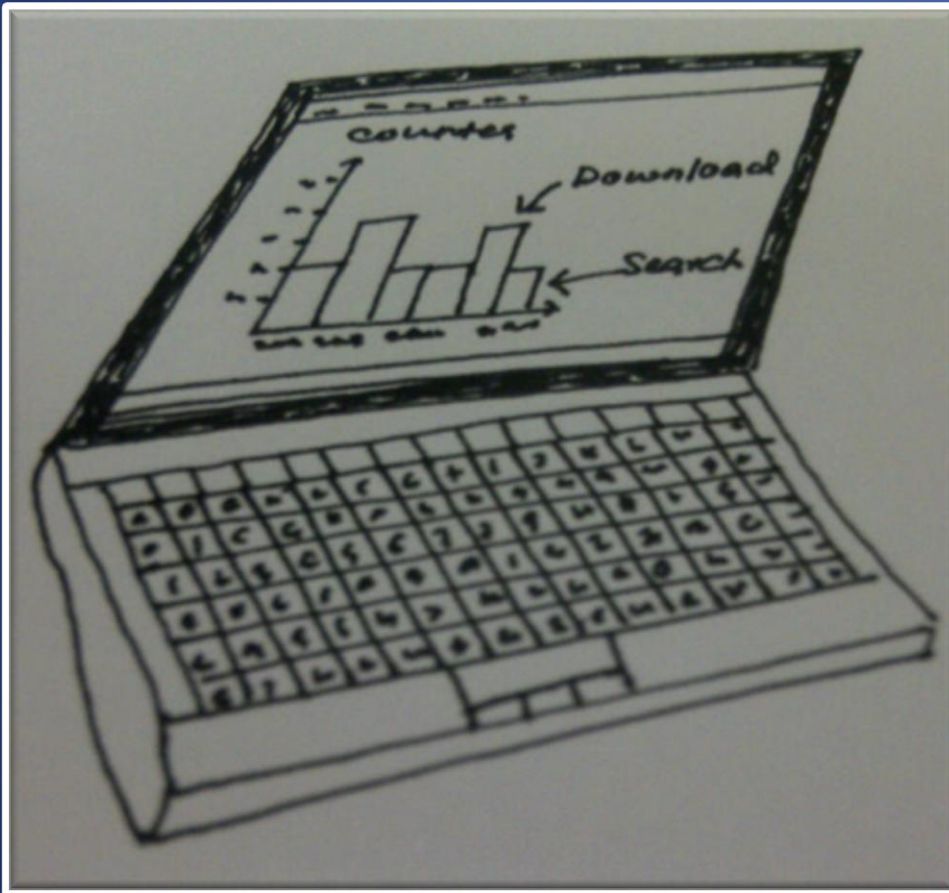


USE OF ELECTRONIC RESOURCES @ UniMAP

Number of Downloads (2004-2011)

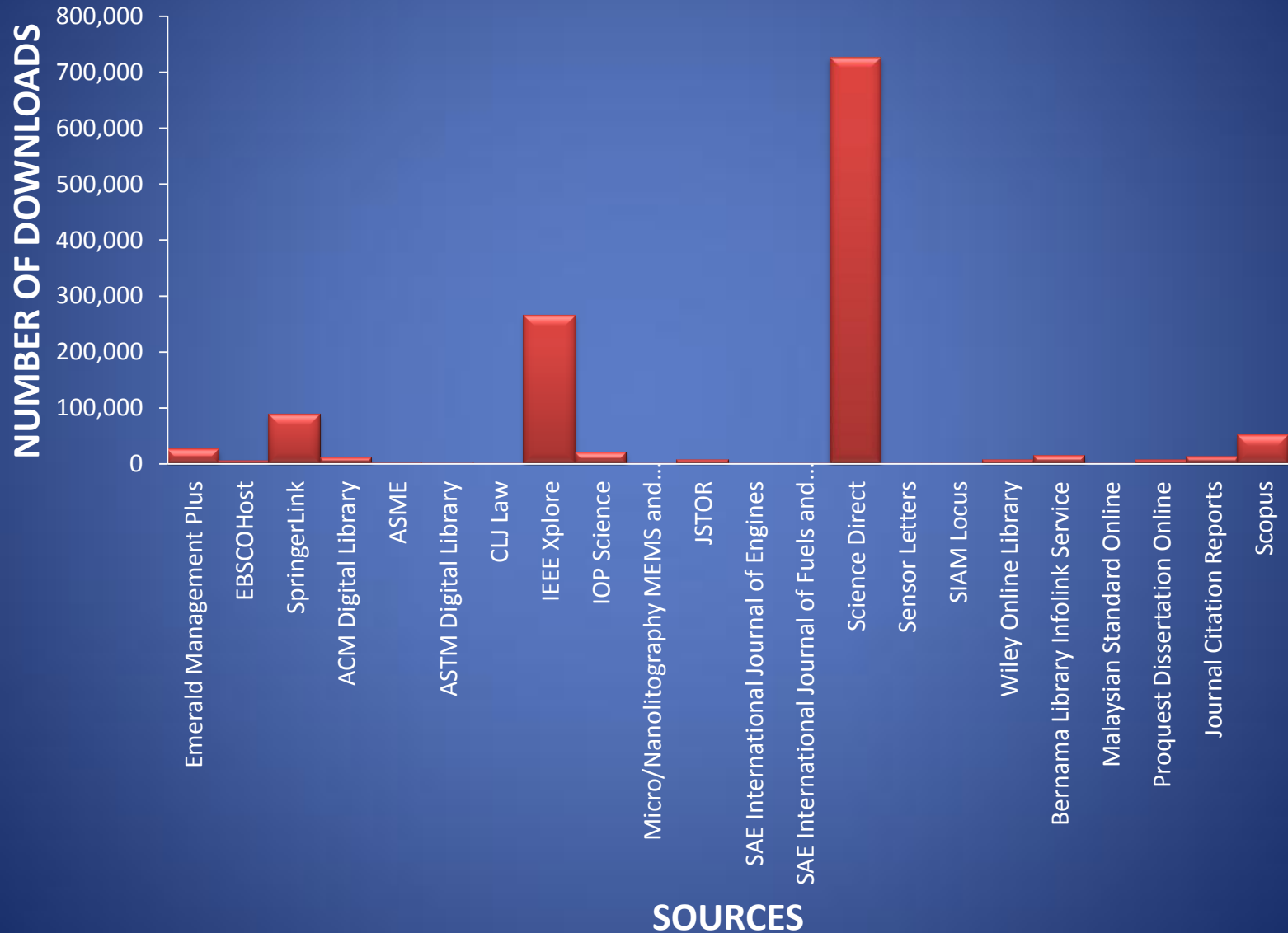


STATISTICAL INDICATORS FOR ELECTRONIC ACCESS

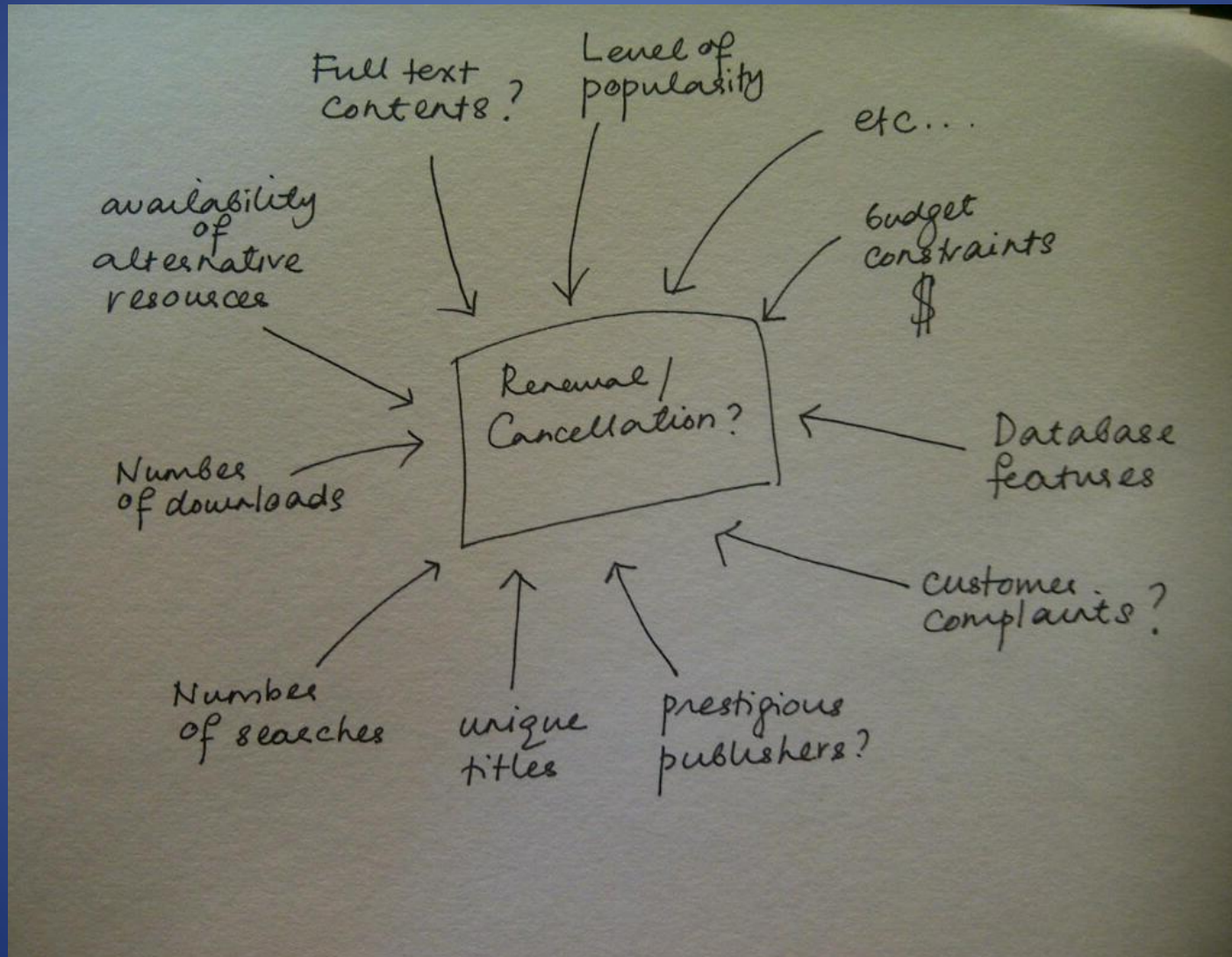


- ❑ Number of downloads, number of searches, number of sessions (COUNTER)
- ❑ Determine relevant and highly used databases
- ❑ Some relevant, unique databases are not optimized by users
- ❑ Academic staff plays important role in promoting online databases (teaching-learning)

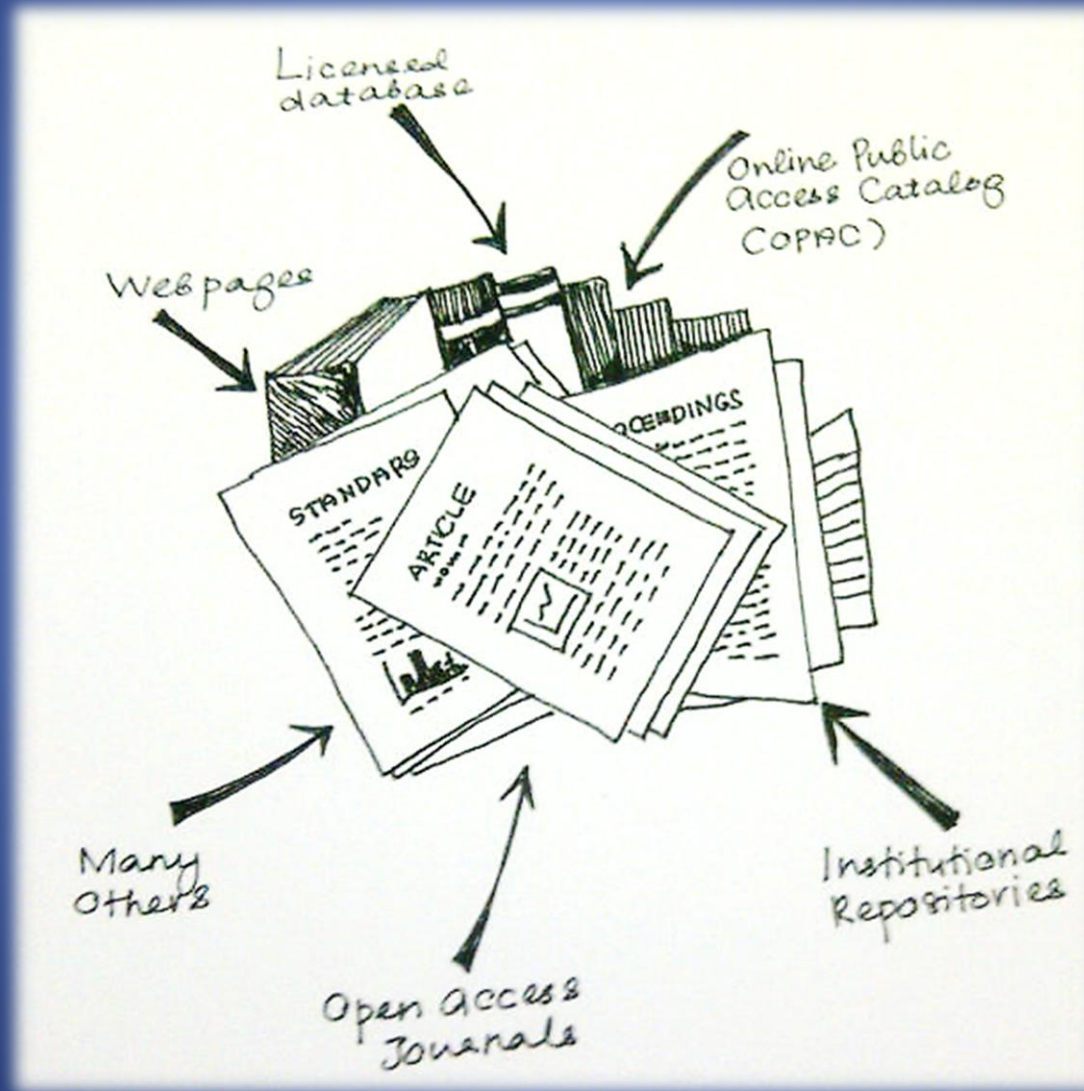

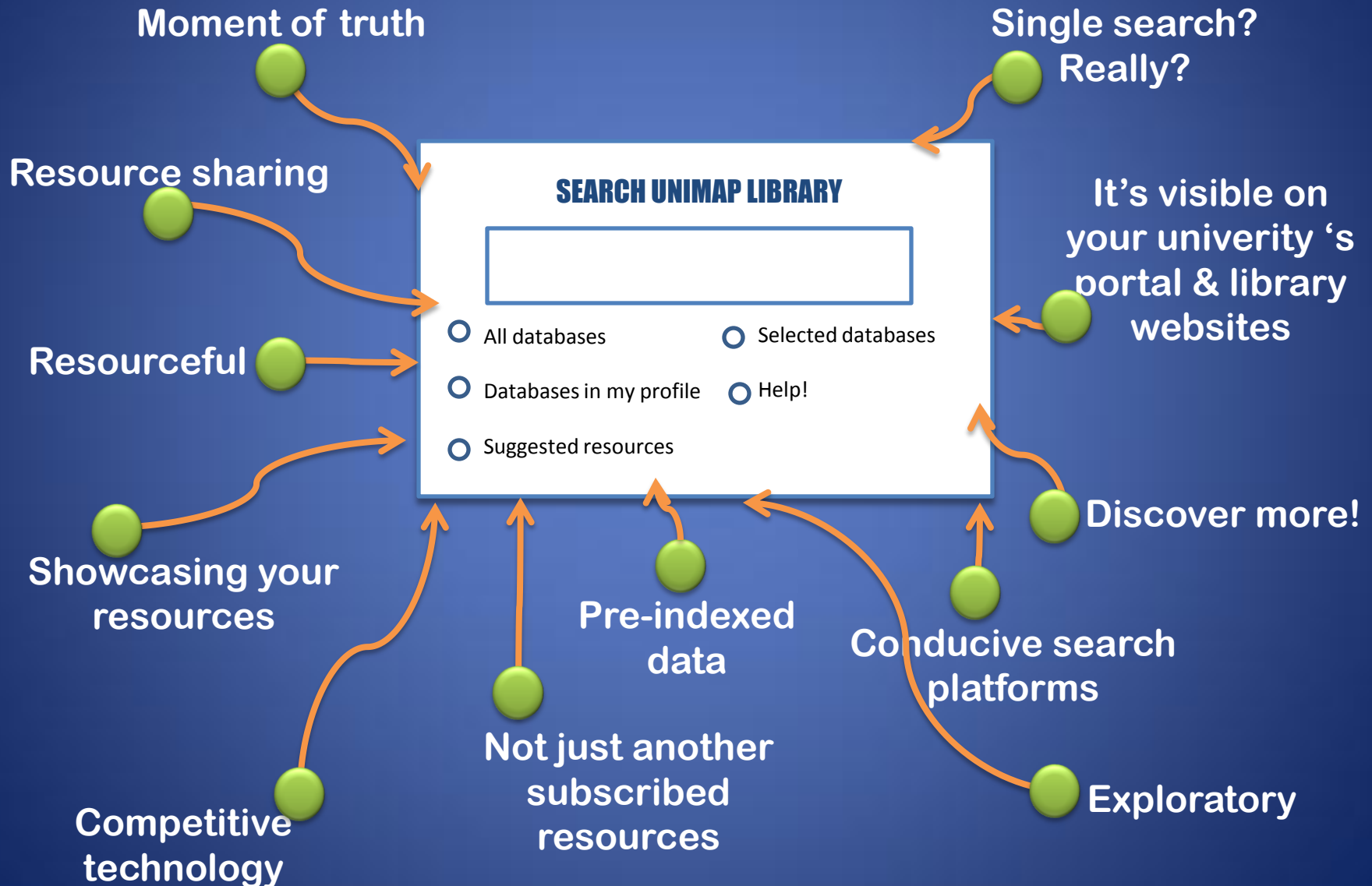
