- Discovering and encouraging the fun in reading
- All access to the right book for the right child
- Emphasizing the importance of reading out loud
- Prevention of low literacy



BookStart – How?

- Professional activities for babies and toddlers
- Seminars for preschool teachers
- Workshops about reading aloud for parents
- Information about apps and safe digital media

Primary Schools – What?

- Encouraging pupils to read more and more often (fun versus technique)
- Teaching rational usage of internet, social media and games (21th century skills)
- Organising activities involving books, reading and discovering digital media
- Helping schools and parents achieving these goals and activities

Secondary Schools – What?

Providing classes and programmes about:

- Critical information literacy
- Online privacy & Filter bubbles
- Hate speech & Cyber bullying
- Access to literature and scientific data



Secondary Schools – How?

- Team of regular librarians with didactic skills
- In close dialogue with mentors at schools
- At schools at the students grounds
- Simultaneous lessons in multiple classrooms
