

WorldShare ILL connects you to thousands of libraries worldwide and allows you to view their collections at a glance in WorldCat®.

Learn basic functionality quickly. WorldShare ILL is simple to learn and teach to staff with any level of experience. Even your library generalists and student workers can help with ILL tasks. And you can set up your library's policies and other standard information in advance to make sure they're correctly included on every request.

Automate your ILL workflows. Simplify your processes with automations that route requests to the next library automatically when one library can't fulfill a request. The automated request manager ensures that fewer ILL requests require staff intervention, allowing you to focus on those requests that require more time and attention.

Deliver electronic resources quickly and safely.

Library users today expect fast delivery. With WorldShare ILL, copy requests sent to the global network are typically filled within 24 hours—sometimes in as little as 15 minutes. You can post these electronic documents on a secure portal where only the user who made the request can access them.

Simplify ILL payments and fees. Check-writing and managing invoices and payments for ILL fees takes time away from more value-added tasks. WorldShare ILL enables you to consolidate all ILL charges and payments into your OCLC invoice, reconciling a month's worth of transactions at once—saving time and effort. Participating libraries report an average savings of more than \$45 USD (\$55 AUD or €36) per request.

Easily create reports to demonstrate the value of ILL.WorldShare ILL includes pre-defined statistical reports you can share with others to show how ILL contributes to the overall value of your library. These reports can

Automate to ensure faster delivery and save time. Ensure fewer ILL requests require staff intervention with the automated request manager. WorldShare ILL also lets you simplify processes with preset policies and preferences, shipping information, and preferred lenders and groups.

By joining Libraries Very Interested in Sharing (LVIS), you can borrow materials at no cost from 2,400+ participating institutions that reciprocate lending of materials. Eliminate invoicing and check writing with OCLC's ILL Fee Management (IFM), consolidating credits and debits into one monthly invoice.

Deliver documents that users can access securely, quickly, and easily. Article Exchange offers a secure location within WorldShare ILL to upload a requested document and provide access only to the user who made the request. Documents are available for five views or 30 days by default, ensuring copyright compliant.

Receive requests from any discovery service. You can provide a customized ILL request form to receive user requests in WorldShare ILL without rekeying them. Library users access this OpenURL-based form from any discovery service, including WorldCat Discovery.

Exceed your library users' expectations with fast interlibrary loan

When Laura D'Amato, Head of Access Services and Interlibrary Loan, joined Baldwin Wallace University's Ritter Library, she realized their ILL workflows had been the same for a long time. To learn about the smart fulfillment capabilities, Laura attended OCLC's live training and watched recorded training videos.

Leveraging what she learned, Laura set up borrowing automations in WorldShare ILL. As a result, their borrowing turnaround times were reduced by 20 hours for copies and by two days for physical items. And once real-time availability was implemented, Laura said, "It's helpful because when I look at our Can You Supply? queue, I know the requests won't be for checked out items." Because of their participation in the Express program, their users now get copy requests delivered 50% faster.
