


Participation Instructions for OCLC Data Labeling

Help improve WorldCat for users everywhere—if you know MARC records, we want you!


To validate and enhance our AI machine learning model’s understanding of duplicate records in WorldCat, simply follow these instructions:

- 1) Visit <https://labelduplicates.worldcat.org>.
- 2) Click “Login” in the upper right corner of the screen and enter your WorldShare credentials. For login assistance, please [reference the FAQs](#).

- 3) Once logged in, you can select a subset of records by choosing the desired attributes from the dropdown menu under language of resource, material type (please see [code definitions](#) for more information), and age of record.

This will generate a pair of records matching the defined criteria. If you do not have a preference, simply leave the pre-populated characteristics in each field, click “Generate Pair”.

- 6) **Then please select the checkbox** (to the left of the row) for any field particularly important or noteworthy in supporting your decision. This helps train and refine the algorithm more accurately and quickly. (Note: Some fields, such as 6xx fields, are not displayed since they are not useful in determining record equivalency. 880 fields are displayed adjacent to their Latin equivalents.)
