Subject Suggester Summary

Title:

Subject Suggester

Brief Description:

Subject Suggester enables cataloguers to search subject authority records with results relevance ranked and export selected subject headings into the cataloguing module of the local system.

System Requirements:

No specific hardware requirements (current hardware used in National Library is Dell Poweredge 2850, two dual core Intel Xeon CPUs, 16GB memory, on Redhat enterprise 4 Linux). Software requirements: Java runtime, Jetty servlet/JSP container, Lucene.

Features and Uses:

Keyword searching of complete authority records; relevance ranking of results; links to national bibliographic database; export selected subject headings into the cataloguing module of the local system to minimize typing and typos; potential to include classification data and culling tool.

Access/Availability:

We are still in a development stage, but once development is complete, we will look to give away the program as-is. However, the full Library of Congress Subject Authority file in our search database is proprietary, and access will need to be negotiated separately with the Library of Congress.
