

## CONTENTdm Flex Loader 6.1 Features

CONTENTdm Flex Loader 6.1 includes the following new features. More information about version 6.1, including an updated Getting Started Guide and download kit for upgrading, is available on the User Support Center (login required).

**Additional date format support** – 3 additional date formats (based on ISO8601 standard) are now supported: MM/DD/YYYY, YYYY-MM and YYYY.

**Print PDF creation** – An option to create a print PDF of a newspaper or monograph is available as part of regular file processing. A complete PDF will be generated from single page JP2 or TIFF files provided by a user. The print PDF will be available to end users for printing and downloading from the collection website.

**Multiple articles in one newspaper section highlighted as single articles** – When the METS file for a newspaper issue identifies one section containing multiple articles, the end user will see each article in the section highlighted instead of the entire section of articles highlighted.

**Advertisements in a newspaper highlighted and titled** – Individual advertisements in a newspaper issue will be highlighted for the end user, and each ad will display a title based on the attributes identified in the METS file.

**Page number and sequence number extracted from CCS newspaper** – The ORDER attribute identified in the METS file previously was used as the page number for a newspaper in the CCS format. Now ORDER will be used as the sequence number and ORDERLABEL will be used as the page number only in the CCS format for newspaper issues.

**Activation Request Form eliminated** – Previously users were required to submit an Activation Request Form on the User Support Center and wait up to two weeks for confirmation of Flex Loader license activation. Now users may get started by downloading and installing the application from the User Support Center. Authenticated use of Flex Loader will be based on a currently active CONTENTdm Server license. Flex Loader version 5.4 users do not need to make any changes to their existing installation, but you will want to upgrade to version 6.1 to take advantage of the new features and bug fixes.

### Other

**System Requirements revised** – CONTENTdm Server 5.1 is now the minimum version required to use Flex Loader 6.1. Previously the minimum Server version was 5.0. Please note that Flex Loader 6.1 will be compatible with CONTENTdm 6.1 when it releases.

### Fixes

In addition to the new features listed above, Flex Loader 6.1 includes fixes to several known issues. See the Flex Loader 6.1 Release Notes on the Downloads page of the User Support Center for a complete list of fixed issues.
